## **Progress update on the East End Project**

Work started on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2011 and is focusing on the North Transept area. The plaster on the interior wall has been removed and the timbers on the exterior wall are being cut out and replaced. The work is generating significant dust inside, however the contractors will clean up on Friday afternoons, and we are grateful to the cleaning team for keeping on top of things
