Progress update on the East End Project


The contractors have begun work on the walls at the east end and also on the Lych Gate path.

The site progress meeting indicated work is going well on time and within budget. The contractors have been instructed to fix the **path near the south porch** as it is a health and safety hazard. This work will be paid for by the council.

Our architect has recommended a contractor for the **stained glass repairs and renovations** and we have received approval for this work to proceed from Archdeacon Cherry Vann and the DAC Secretary under the East End faculty.
