East End Project Update –

- All interior work is complete and signed off.
- Additional work needs to be done on the exterior painting to ensure it meets the quality standards.
- Exterior lighting should be fixed within two weeks.
- We are contacting our local councilors to continue the success we have achieved so far, to gain assistance to level the remaining paths and raise awareness of our BIG community focused project

We are now focusing on the BIG project for next year – level floors, new heating and possible re-ordering of the south transept. Please continue to feed in your comments on the post-it-notes in the baptistery. It is very important that we gather all individual views on this project.

PCC Meeting 22/09/11 voted and accepted following:-

- 1. **Pews will be reinstalled** in the main body of the Church only and they will be made 'move-able' i.e. not fixed to the floor.
- Permission was given for our architect to proceed to the application for advice stage for the full project as presented in the plans.

Further decisions about the extent and detail of the project will be made later when we have consulted the appropriate bodies and have detailed costings.
